ALL DAY COURSE8am-5pm\$1508hr CESoil Gas Mitigation – Compliance Inspector Course | NRPP ID # KSU-8000 (8 Cat I hrs)

The NRPP Soil Gas Mitigation Compliance Inspector is for those who inspect ASD systems to verify if the installation complies with the ANSI-AARST Soil-Gas Mitigation Standard. SGM Compliance Inspectors have access to the AARST mitigation inspection app used to perform a visual assessment and generate a compliance report. Their role is to represent home buyers by verifying if systems installed as part of a home sale meet the minimum standards, help resolve citizen complaints to NRPP, and assist state radon programs with compliance enforcement. This course is a pre-requisite to the SGM-CI Exam. The exam is not required.
